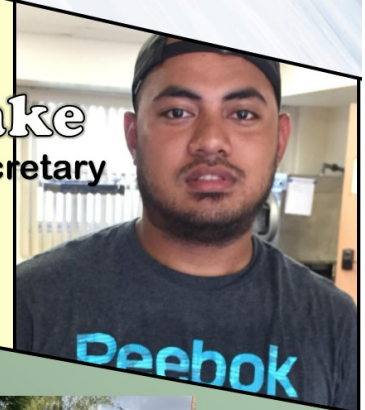
Hideichi Treasurer
