QUESTION & ANSWER SHEET NO. 1 May 3, 2021

In response to the written "Questions" and/or 'Request for Clarifications' UOG received as of April 26, 2021 @ 5:44pm from vendor: IT&E.

Question 1: When does the University anticipate the date of the initial purchase activation?

Answer: UOG confirms once we award, we would like to begin community announcements and distribution by July 19, 2021. The Fanuchånan (Fall) semester is scheduled to start on Aug 18, 2021.

Question 2: Does the University anticipate the extension of service to May 2022 to coincide with the end of the Spring semester?

Answer: UOG confirms the service is expected to continue through the summer of 2022. The last day of Summer Session C classes is August 6, 2022.

Question 3: Device Distribution - Will the awarded vendor be allowed to establish a distribution site on the University Campus?

Answer: UOG confirms not at this time. Currently the campus is closed and under restricted access for employees and selected in-person activities. If a change in the Governor's Executive Order changes our situation, we may be able to discuss this option with the vendor.

Question 4: Indefinite Quantity Bid - What is the estimated minimum and / or initial quantity requested? This is needed to determine baseline and best pricing for the University.

Answer: UOG confirms based on a recent student survey, about 25% of the respondents reported having no internet access off-campus. Therefore, a minimum number of 750 units are expected for this bid.
